Home of Elin & Emil Nummi—1920's - Weirton

Come and learn the story of *Titanic* survivor, Elin Hakkarainen, who was rescued after the *Titanic* struck an iceberg on its maiden voyage 100 years ago, April 14, 1912. Elin’s husband and over 1500 others went down with the ship. Elin went on with her life and eventually came to Weirton, where she remarried to a steelworker named Emil Nummi, living in a house on Avenue I in the 1920’s. The home still exists today and will receive a commemorative plaque.
